Instructions for Abstract Submission

Format and Size: The abstract should be written in Word and must not exceed one A4 page.

Language: The abstract must be submitted in both Greek and English.

Margins: Top and bottom 2.5 cm, left and right 3.0 cm.

Font: Abstracts should be in Times New Roman, 10 pt, black font, with bold used for paragraph titles.

Line spacing: Single space, no space between paragraphs.

Title: Bold, centered on the page in Times New Roman, size 11.

Authors: After the title, leaving one blank line, list the authors' names (surname, first name) in Times New Roman, 10 pt, bold and italic. The name of the presenting author must be underlined. One blank line follows, then the authors' affiliations in 10 pt font. NOTE: Authors are responsible for the accuracy of their details and must use the official names of their institutions. If more than one institution is listed, use superscript numbers to distinguish them.

Corresponding Author: Include the corresponding author's email address and telephone number.

Keywords: List 3–5 keywords separated by commas.

Abstract Text: Leave one blank line before starting the fully justified abstract text. The abstract should be between 250 and 350 words maximum.

Sections: The abstract must include Introduction, Aim, Material and Methods, Results, Conclusions, References (up to 5), and Keywords.

Saving and Submitting the Abstract: The abstract should be saved and sent in .doc/.docx format, and the file should be named using the first author's surname. Abbreviations should be used only for commonly known terms. For unfamiliar terms, abbreviations should be minimized and introduced in parentheses after the full term appears once.

Abstracts must be submitted in conference's website on the deadline that will be announced. Authors are required to type their abstracts directly into the attached "Electronic Abstract Submission Template".
